Each of the organizations has submitted an application to federal agencies that can sponsor its request. The proposed sponsoring agency has been identified. Many of the requesting organizations have submitted multiple conveyance requests for the same purpose with an order of preference. The stated order of preference has been maintained in this table where appropriate. Multiple requests for the same purpose have been listed separately.
