1. Continue outreach related to munitions cleanup work in the northern portion of the Fort Ord National Monument with emphasis on outreach prior to vegetation cutting near Happy Trails.
2. Initiate 2018 burn season announcements and outreach activities on 15JUN18.
3. Evaluate results of 2017 community survey and publish draft analysis report.
