## Long Term Actions Underway:

1. Continue outreach related to munitions cleanup work in the northern portion of the Fort Ord National Monument with emphasis on outreach prior to vegetation cutting near Happy Trails.
2. Began burn season. Responded to email and hotline inquiries and direct notification enrollment requests. Number of participants enrolled in **Direct Notification as of 5JUL: 557.**
3. Evaluate results of 2017 community survey and publish draft analysis report.
