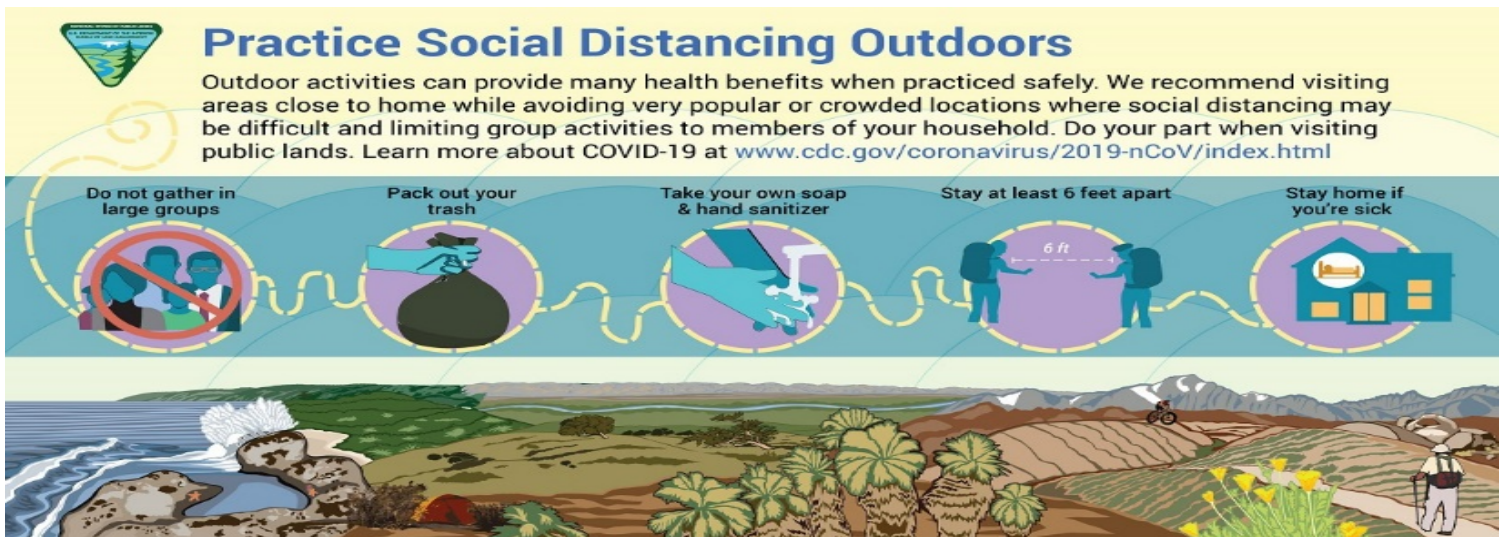
1. Emailed and mailed notices regarding cancellation of July 18th Community Involvement Workshop.
