



The munitions response for Range 36A is in progress. The vegetation on the 1.8-acre area of Range 36A was removed (cut) in preparation for the munitions response action. A digital (EM-61) survey of the area identified significant subsurface anomalies. One range-related debris item was treated (wholly inert 250-pound General Purpose practice bomb). Excavation of subsurface areas per agreement between Army and DTSC is complete. No MEC was discovered.

PROJECT: MRS-BLM 2007 Removal Action

A munitions response action is scheduled for a portion of MRS-BLM in 2007 in accordance with the Track 3 ROD. The area scheduled for removal is comprised of approximately 832 acres of the southwestern-most portion of the MRS-BLM bordered by the City of Del Rey Oaks to the west, Watkins Gate Road to the North and South Boundary Road to the south. The 2007 removal area is broken into burn units of 100+ acres for the purpose of planning and controlling vegetation removal. Burn units A, B, and C, a total of approximately 520 acres, are separated from burn units D and E, a total of approximately 312 acres, geographically to limit the size of contiguous burn areas.

- Excavation of those anomalies and the conduct of appropriate QC/QA processes
