1. Continue outreach related to munitions cleanup work in the northern portion of the Fort Ord National Monument.
2. Responded to email and hotline inquiries on burn program and direct notification enrollment requests. 993 participants enrolled in Direct Notification as of 7NOV.
3. Complete evaluation results of 2017 community survey and 2017-2019 outreach activities. Publish draft analysis report January 2019.
