






PROPOSED SIGNAGE FOR UNIT A PERIMETER



PG&E SAFETY UPDATES

- BRAC, BLM, and FORA met with PG&E leadership in September.
- BRAC provided GIS mapping shapefiles to PG&E.
- PG&E will place warnings in mapping system for work in former Fort Ord.
- BRAC designed a sign to alert utility workers they may not enter Impact Area until coordinating with BRAC office. PG&E will get the sign made.
- BRAC removed PG&E padlocks from Impact Area.
- BRAC coordinated with PG&E on root cause analysis of pole-change-out project.
- PG&E managers and staff attended UXO Safety & Awareness Training.
