

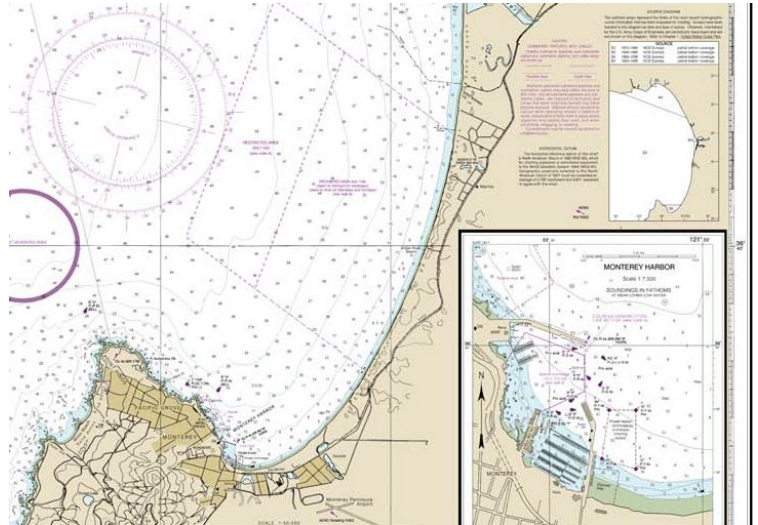
U.S. Army Community Outreach Update

Long Term Actions Underway:

1. The Army will issue the 2021 community outreach survey in April. Survey will be accepted through June 30, 2021.

Recent Activities:

1. 11FEB Held Technical Review Committee meeting—call in only (27).
2. 23FEB Provided Fort Ord cleanup Zoom presentation to Environmental Studies class at Pacific Grove High School.
3. 1MAR Responded to community member inquiry on property transfer information. Referred to Monterey County.
4. 5MAR Added trespassing notice (right) to web site.
5. 5MAR Updated and cleaned 4 of the 8 BLM Area B kiosks. Talked to several individuals while completing this work.
6. 25MAR Added a new Fact Sheet to the web site in response to the Impact Area trespassing incidents.
7. 30APR Received inquiry from potential home buyer in the Sea Haven “Cove” neighborhood.
8. 30MAR Received media request from Associated Press for general information about the Fort Ord cleanup project. Tour and interview are tentatively scheduled for the end of 27 or 28 April.
9. 30MAR Received comment/request via web site comment form. NOAA official wrote Charts and the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) (33 CFR § 334.1150) both still refer to a danger zone for a firing range. The regulations state, "(iii) The regulations in this paragraph will be enforced by the Commanding General, Fort Ord, California. Bill Collins responded to the request.
10. March Various email communications with Mike Weaver, Fort Ord Community Advisory Group, regarding interview questions for the development of the Preliminary Assessment for PFAS.
