 - Surveillance
 - POMPD and BLM Law Enforcement Impact Area Patrols (daily)
 - BRAC Site Inspections approximately up to five times per week
 - Six motion-activated cameras at rotating locations since 5/28/2021.
 - Formed draft protocol for independent camera system.
 - Independent camera system under testing.
 - Maintenance of Impact Area fence, signs and gates:
 - BLM perimeter fence inspection and repairs (weekly)
 - Reinforced wires in areas of recent trespass incidents (Impossible Canyon Gate north)
 - Gate Access Signage updated with Security Manager cell phone number
 - Signage maintenance on Impact Area MRA perimeter fence.
 - One large UXO sign to be updated (South Boundary Road near Laguna Seca)
 - Other Activities
 - The ongoing weekend closure of Parker Flats gate started on 8/5/22.
 - Supported PG&E planned work and inspections in the Impact Area MRA as needed.
 - Updated the Law Enforcement Jurisdictions and Gates Map, to be distributed to local law enforcement.
 - MRS Security Program Annual Report is in development.
 - BRAC updated Impact Area MRA access protocol for BLM, MPC, and others to avoid conflict between various activities.
