





# Site 39 Inland Ranges Habitat Restoration Status Update

#### July 13, 2024 Community Involvement Workshop (CIW)

- Three Harris-Terracon team members attended the CIW and staffed the habitat restoration booth.
- The habitat restoration booth featured updated progress information, maps, an informative video, photo points, and native plants and seeds on display. Additionally, we provided purple needlegrass and blue wildrye native seed packets to the public. Approximately 24 seed packets were distributed.

### **Caretaker of HAs/Restoration Sites**

- The field team continues the hand removal of invasive tree species.
  - $\circ$   $\,$  A total of 270 invasive trees have been removed this year.
- The field team has been collecting native seeds to supplement erosion control seed mixes.

#### **Upcoming Habitat Restoration Activities**

- Fall photo points will be taken at select locations.
- Fall plant survivorship monitoring will occur at HAs 26, 34, and 37.
- Dry season erosion control repairs will be made in preparation for the wet season.
