## FACTSHEET : Fort Ord Cleanup Administrative Record and Document Library



Fort Ord Cleanup documents are housed in the Fort Ord Cleanup document library which includes documents in the Administrative Record.

The Fort Ord Administrative Record is a specialized file required by the federal Comprehensive Environmental Restoration, Compensation, and Liability Act (also known as CERCLA or Superfund), and contains all information considered or relied on to select the cleanup remedy at the former Fort Ord. **The Fort Ord Cleanup document library also** contains key technical reports and **other materials that inform the community about the environmental cleanup program**.

Each item in the **Fort Ord Cleanup document library** has a unique identifier called a **Document** Number. If you know the **n**umber, this is the fastest way to access an item. Records are grouped into categories (see list below) and are assigned an alpha-numeric **n**umber in one of these categories (example: BW-2107). To view all the records in a particular category, simply type the category into the **Document** Number box and add the **asterisk "\*" wildcard character. For example, to view all the Operable Unit 2 (OU2) records, enter "OU2\*" (without the quotes) in the Document Number box and your results will include all records that have been grouped into the OU2 category.**
