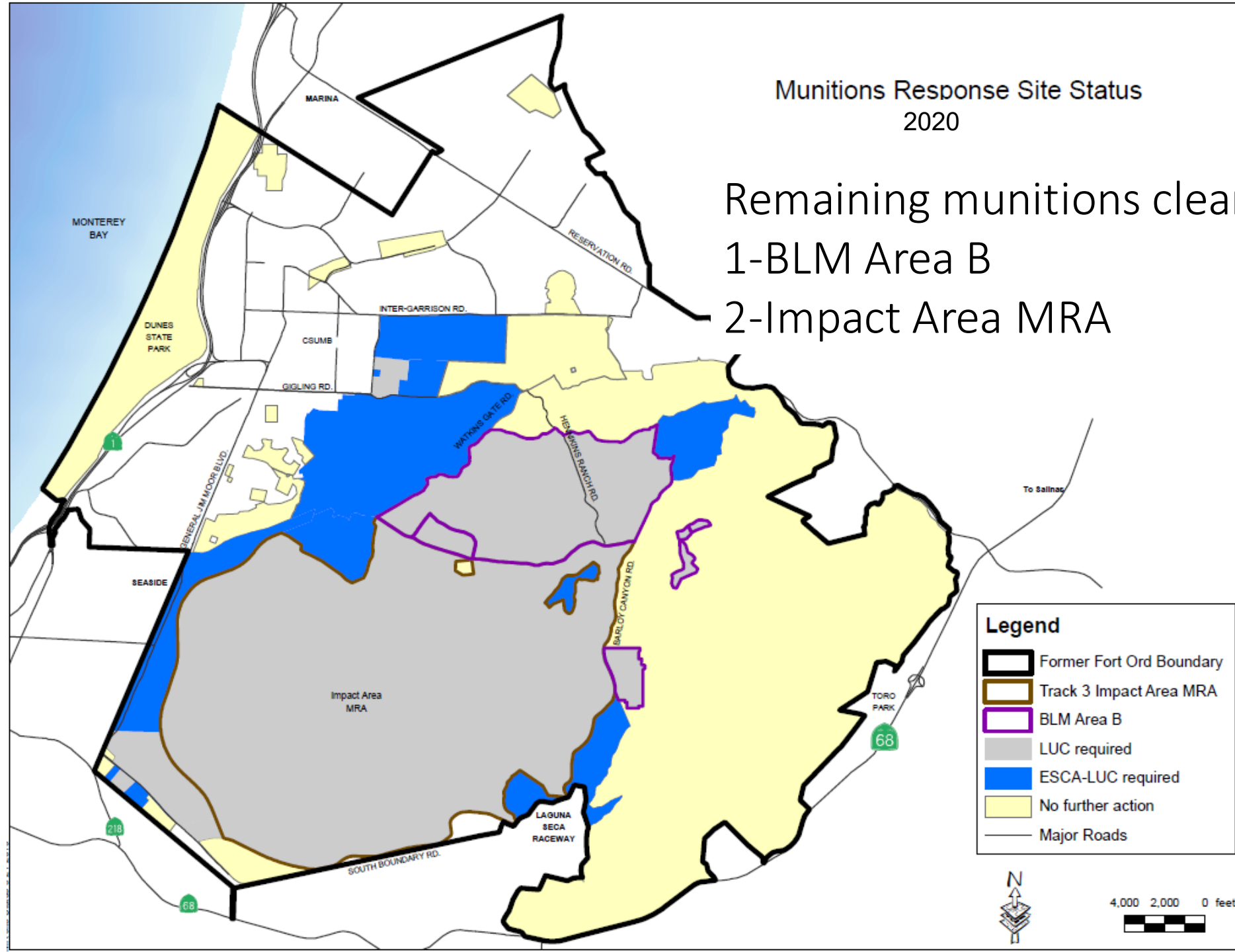

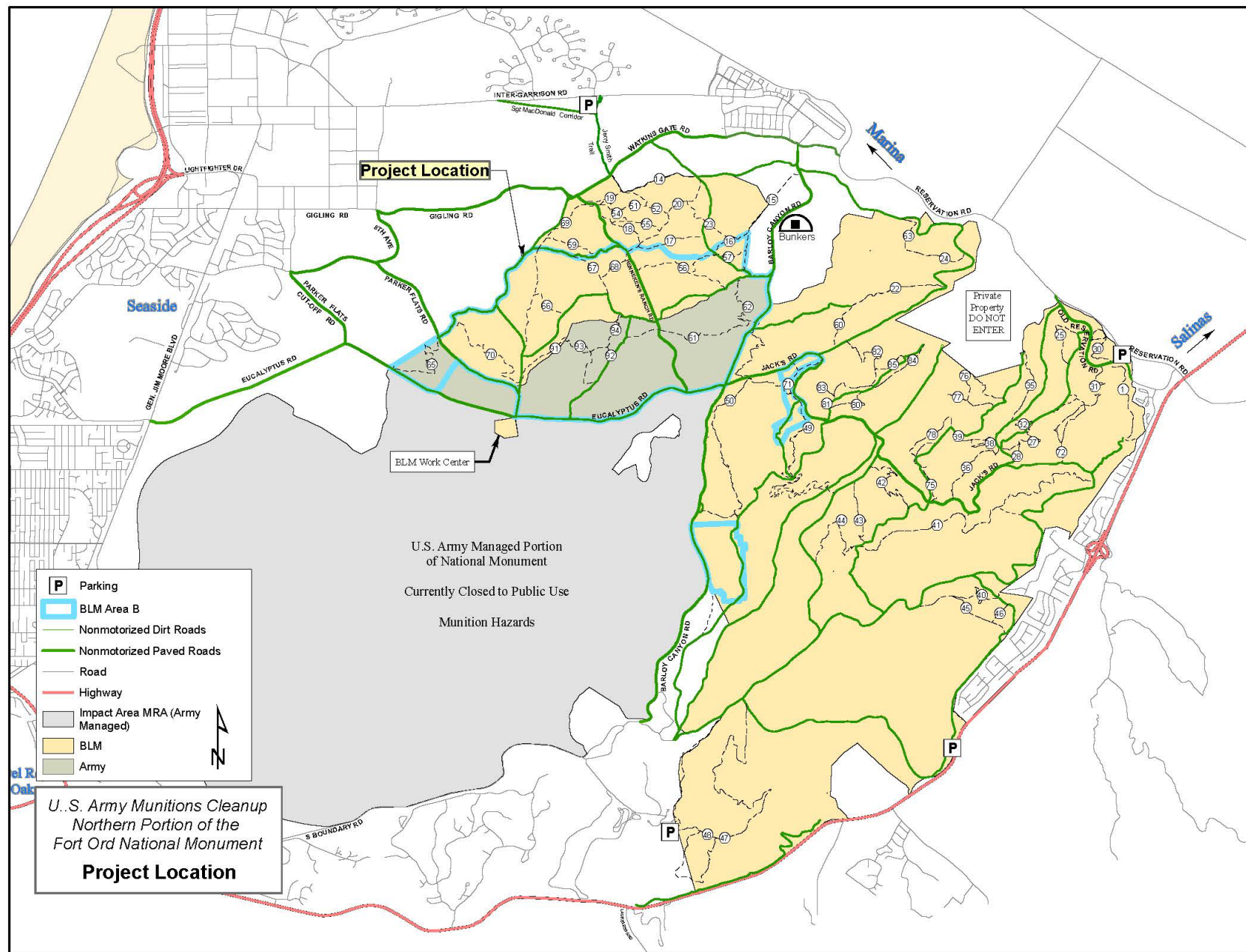
Fort Ord MMRP Timeline

1917-1994	Used for military training – through base closure
1990	Placed on National Priorities List of Superfund sites
1991	Placed on Base Realignment and Closure list
1993	Munitions investigations and removal actions began
1998-2020	Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study – through remedy selection
2007-2019	FORA ESCA remediation program – through site closeout
Present->	Remedial actions continue in parts of Fort Ord National Monument Long-term management of safety programs continue

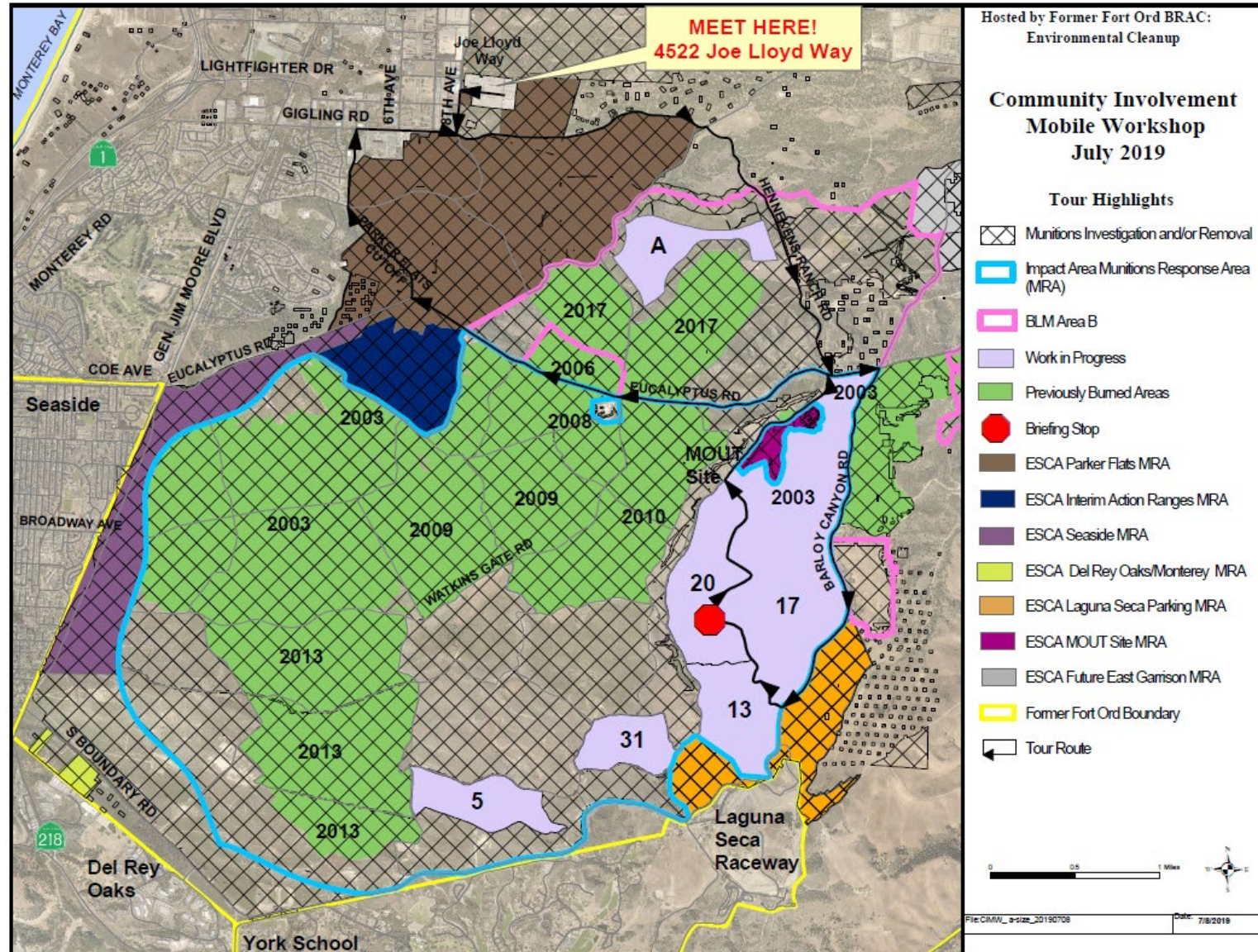
Munitions Response Site Status 2020

2-Impact Area MRA





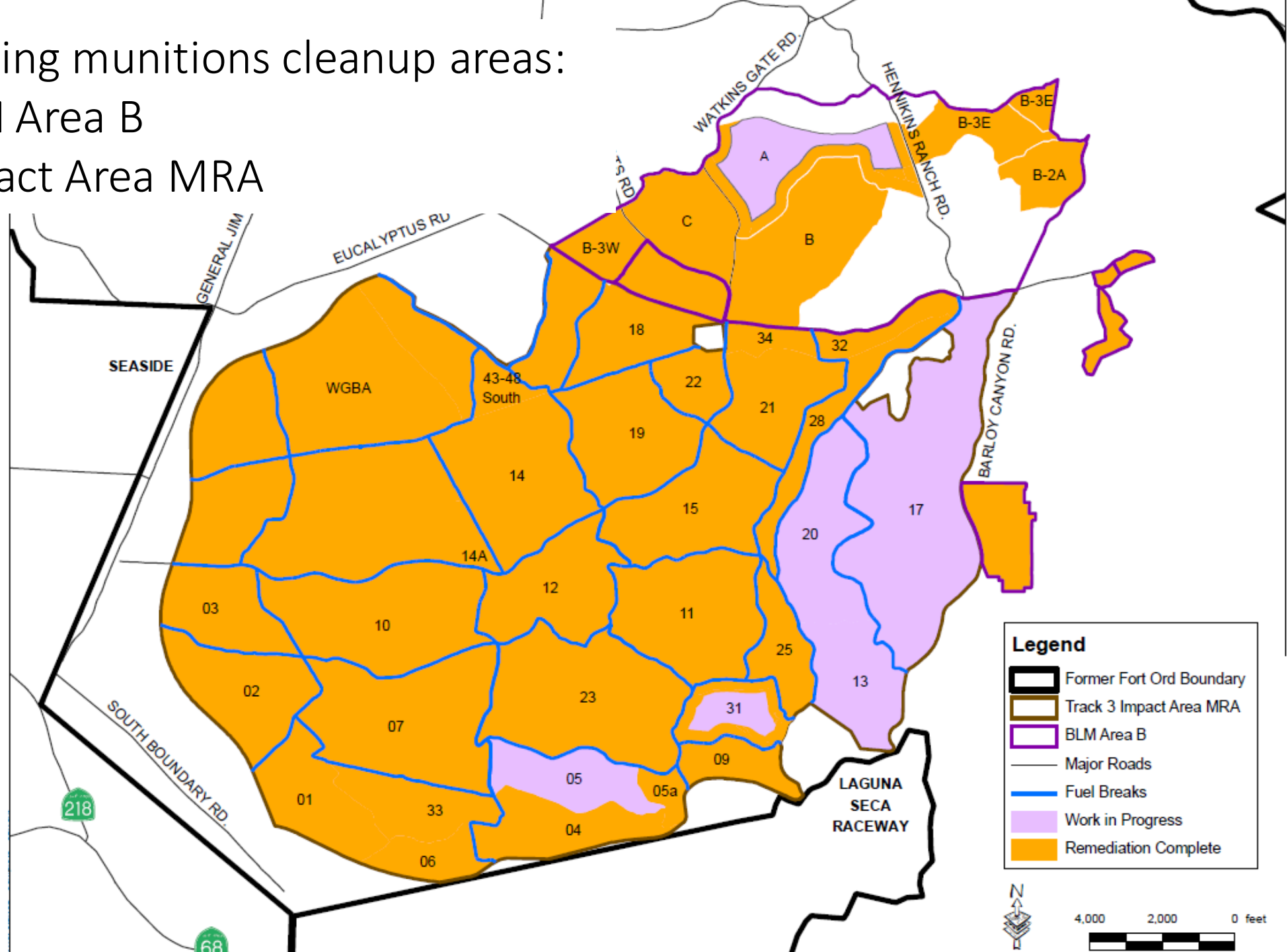

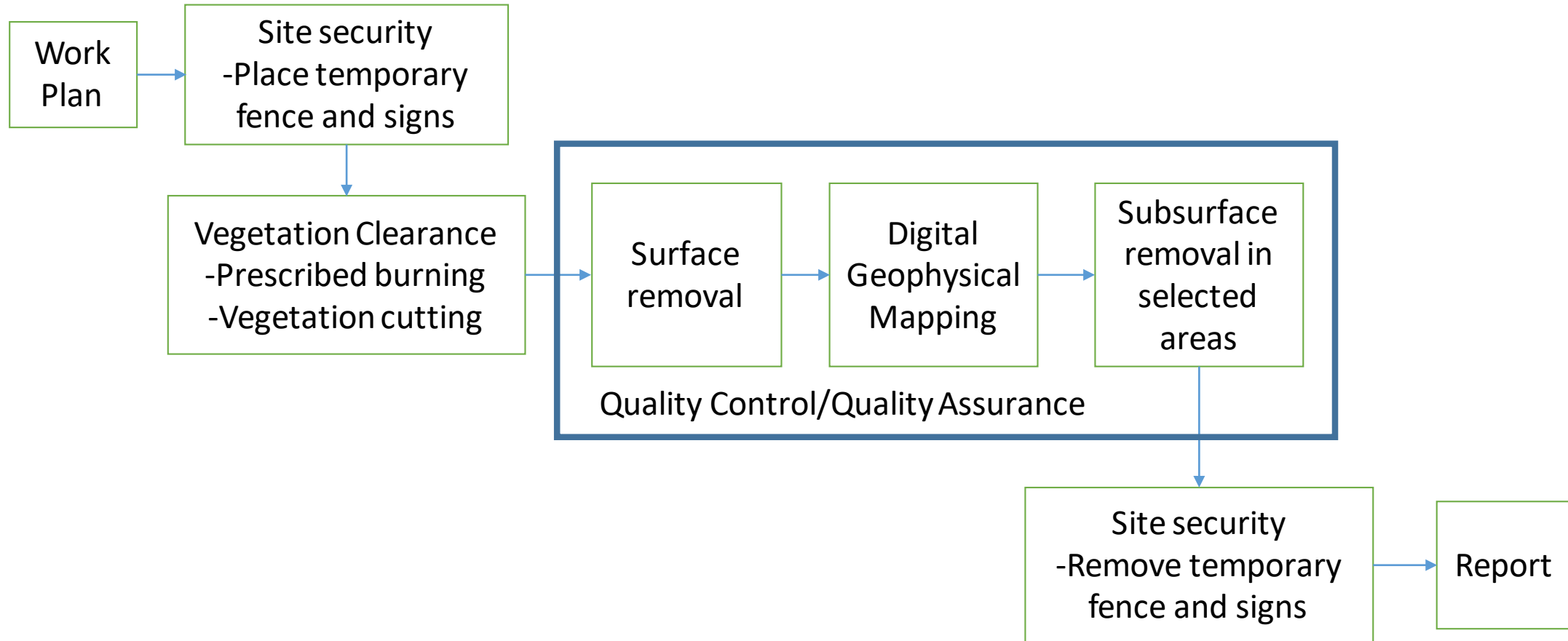

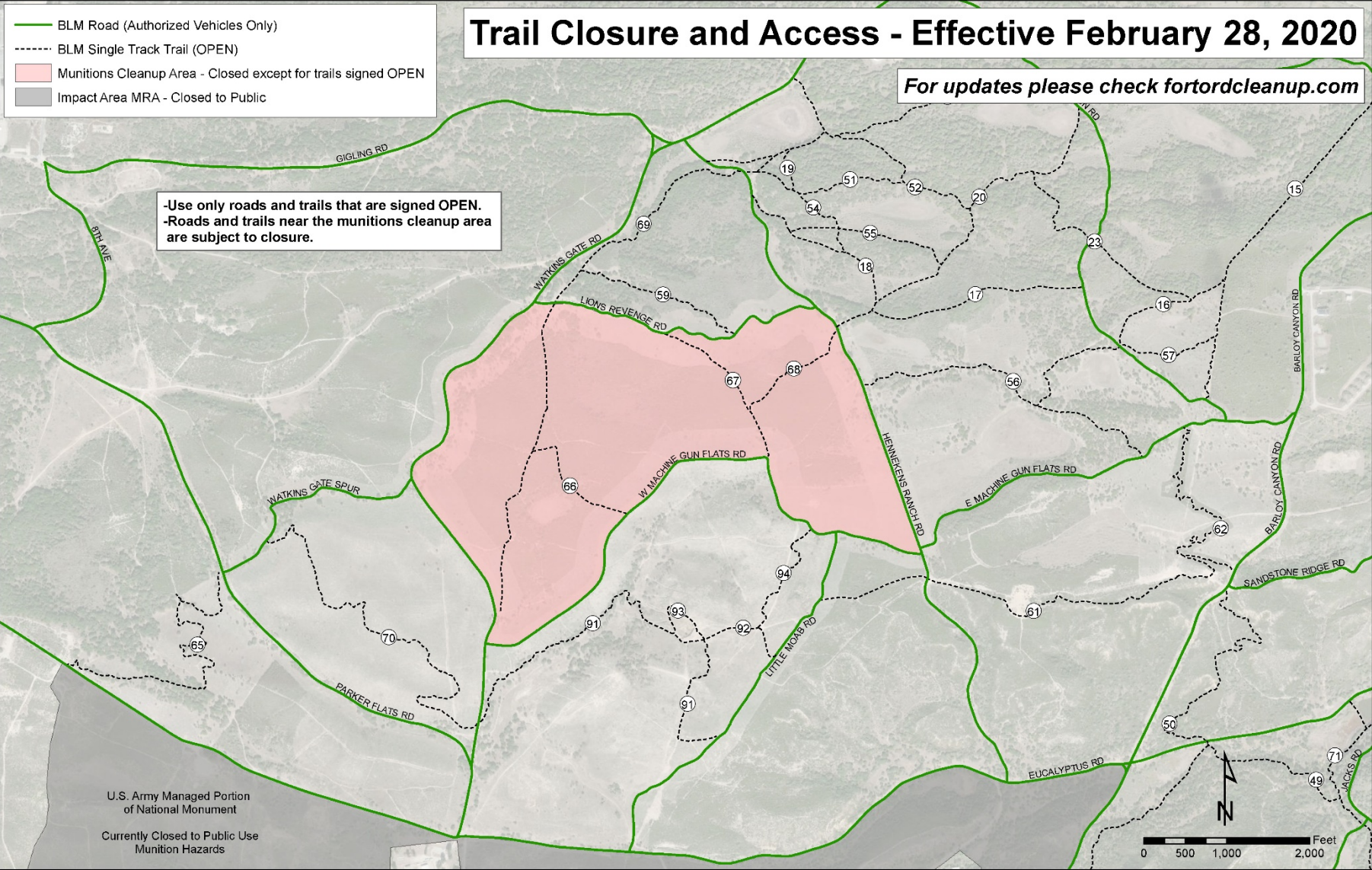


Trails Reopened for Recreational Use



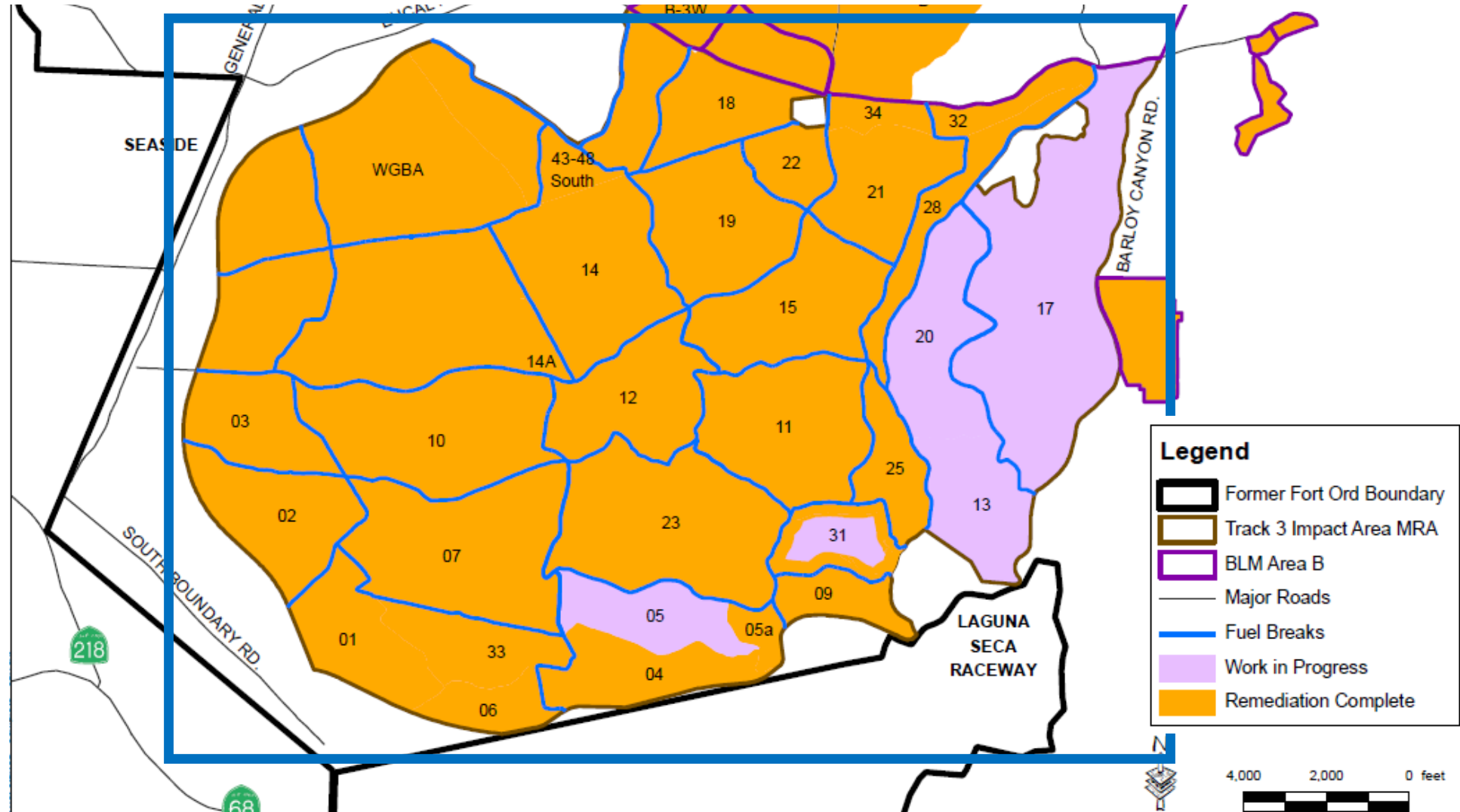


BLM Area B Trail Closure Map February 2020

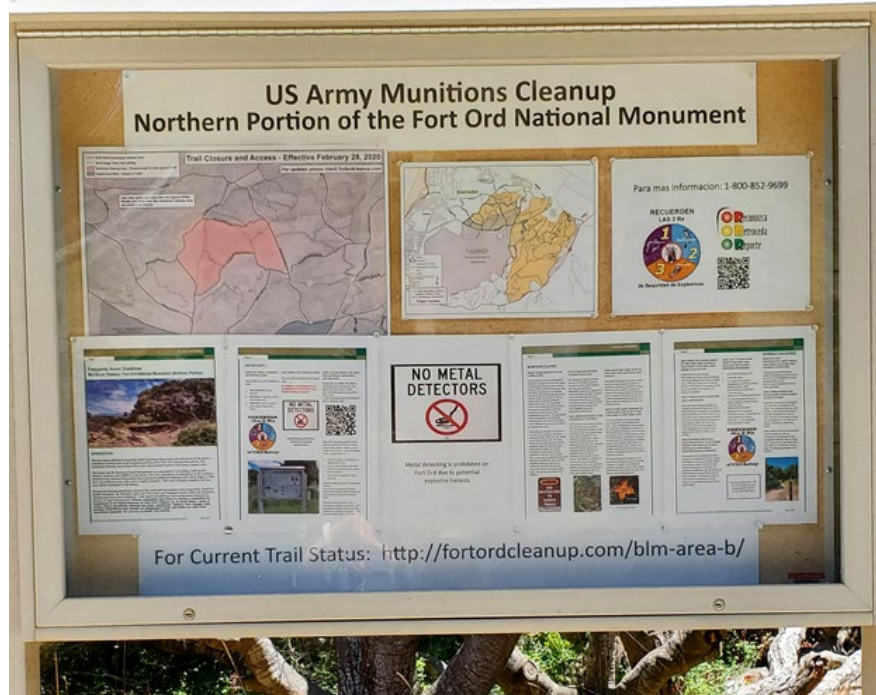
