
Mission

To effectively reduce the threat to public safety by securing dangerous areas and removing hazardous military munitions on the former Fort Ord to a level suitable for reuse.


Objectives

- Locate potential hazardous military munitions areas, assess the hazard, and secure those areas as necessary (Munitions Response Sites (MRS))
- Develop and implement appropriate response actions habitat assessment, vegetation removal, geophysical investigation, military munitions of concern (MEC) removal, quality control, quality assurance, documentation, and monitoring.
- Provide public and technical MEC safety education to the public.
 Inform the community so people area aware of the potential hazards.













Ranges 11/12 DGM (data)




Ranges 11/12 Exclusion Zones (example)






MEC Removal - Non-Burn Areas Fuel Breaks
