Meet within the interior of the National Monument off Jack's Road

What: Paint picnic tables, collect native seed, spread seed and straw, and plant oaks.

Then at noon: Join us for BBQ lunch and music at the intersection of Jacks Road and Skyline Road

Meet at Creekside Terrace Trailhead off Reservation Road

When: October 26, 2013 - 9:00 am


Where: Follow Trailhead signs off Portola Road and Reservation Road


What: Cover graffiti with paint, work on trails, help with landscaping, and pick up litter near trailhead.
